ELIGIBLE WORK

The exhibition is open to all young artists, ages 5 to 17 years old, who live in the state of North Carolina. Paintings, mixed mediums, ceramics, sculpture, multimedia, original hand-made prints, photography, and drawings are all examples of eligible work.

Each young artist may submit one work. The parent or guardian of the artist agrees that any work accepted into the exhibition will remain at CAM for the duration of the exhibition, Saturday August 20 through Sunday, September 25.

ARTWORK DROP-OFF

Each work of art that is dropped off needs to have its own form filled out. While we understand that one adult may drop off work for more than one young artist, we require that each young artist's work of art has its own form filled out. You may print this document in advance and fill it out before you arrive, or you can fill it out when you drop off the work. The adult that signs the paperwork is the person responsible for that work of art, and for picking it up on time.

LIMITATIONS

- One work of art per young artist.
- Flat or 2D work should be no more than 2 ft X 3ft.
- 3D work should be no more than 3 ft X 3 ft X 3 ft.
- We ask that no work weigh more than 25 pounds.
- We ask that each work of art be "display ready" to the best of your ability. For example, framed, created on a gallery wrapped canvas, mounted on a sturdy base, etc.

DELIVERY AND PICK-UP (Please read carefully)

Artwork must be dropped off on Saturday, August 6, along with this completed form, at one of these locations at the designated times:

- Cameron Art Museum, 3201 South 17th Street, 28401 - between 10 AM and 5 PM
- Dreams Center for Arts Education, 901 Fanning Street, 28401 - between 10 AM and 2 PM

There may be a wait during the drop off times so please plan accordingly. Having this form filled out in advance for each work of art will make for a more efficient drop-off.

Please do not drop off artwork before or after these established times. We will not be able guarantee that works dropped off at other times will be included in the exhibition. You may send your child's artwork with another adult that you authorize to assume responsibility of your child's work.

Artwork can be picked up from CAM Thursday, September 29-Sunday, October 2 during regular business hours (Thursday 10 AM to 9 PM, Friday-Sunday 10 AM to 5 PM)

CAM is not responsible for any works that are not picked up at these designated times.
