

Guided Tour Theme: The Power of Observation

PreK-Grade 5

Instill a sense of wonder and curiosity at Cameron Art Museum during this fun and interactive tour! What does it mean to closely look at an artwork? What can we learn from looking longer? Students will expand their observation skills on this field trip through a variety of viewing exercises and artworks. Generative dialogues will be organically orchestrated to develop visual literacy and vocabulary skills. Students will also be introduced to museum etiquette and the many different types of art found in an art museum.

Literacy Instruction Standards
