## IMPORTANT INFORMATION BEFORE REGISTERING FOR 2025 Museum Kids@CAMP

We're excited to welcome your child to **Museum Kids@CAMP 2025!** Before registering, please review these key details to ensure a smooth sign-up process.

### Check CAMP Times & Age Groups

- **CAMPs run 9 AM-12 PM or 2 PM-5 PM**—double-check the session time before registering.
- **Age groups vary weekly:** Ages 5-8, Ages 9-12, and Teen CAMPs (July only). Please register your child in the appropriate age group.
- **Need guidance for siblings?** Contact us for recommendations!

### Member Discounts

- **Members save on CAMP!** Log in before registering to apply your discount.

### What You'll Need for Registration

- **Student Info:** Full name, age, allergies/medical details (including any behavioral, intellectual, or physical considerations).
- **Parent Info:** Name, email, phone, and mailing address.
- **Pickup Authorization:** Name and contact info of any additional authorized individuals.
- **Photo Consent:** Permission for CAM to photograph your child during CAMP.

### How We Stay in Touch

- Expect a **Welcome Email** before CAMP with key details.
- We'll call only if there's a **registration issue** or during the **CAMP week if needed**.

### Registration Confirmation

### Payment Options

- Pay online or over the phone with **all major credit cards**.
- In-person payments (cash, check, or credit) can be made at **CAM's front desk** during museum hours.
- A **non-refundable service fee** applies to all transactions.

### Cancellation Policy

(Refunds only applies to the tuition)

- **Full refund:** Withdraw at least one week before CAMp starts.
- **50% refund:** Withdraw between one week and 72 hours before the start.
- **No refunds:** Withdrawals less than 72 hours before CAMp or missed sessions due to illness.

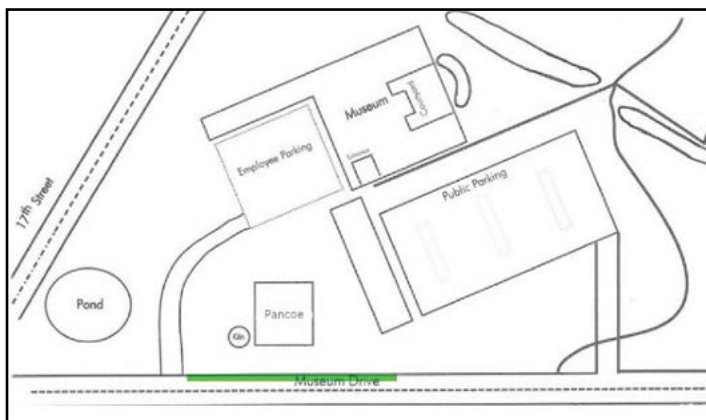
### Waitlist & Scholarships

- If a session is full, contact **Ashley Rowland** at **910-726-9490** to be added to the **waitlist**.
- Limited **needs-based scholarships** are available. Contact Ashley for more details.

### Drop-Off & Pick-Up

- Arrive **no earlier than 10 minutes** before the start of CAMp.
- **Drop-off & pick-up** is on the **Pancoe Education Building porch**. A staff member will sign students in/out daily.

- **Parking:** Follow **Museum Drive** (see photo below) to the **orange cones**. Escort your child to the Pancoe Education Porch. A staff member will sign students in/out daily.



### Health & Safety

- **Sick policy:** Keep children home if they have a fever. They may return **only after being fever-free (without medication) for 24 hours**.
- Apply **sunscreen and bug spray** before arriving.

### What to Bring

- **Attire:** Dress for outdoor play and art activities.
- **Snack & water bottle** (clearly labeled).
- All **art supplies are provided**.
- CAM hosts a **Friday art party** - snack donations are welcome.
